Wealth Tax:

I am aware of recent calls for greater taxes on wealth in order to better fund our public services. I believe that the best way to deliver more money for our public services is through growing our way there. Unfortunately, in my view the Government has instead delivered low growth and loaded the tax burden onto working people.

I therefore believe we need a tax system that is fairer while ensuring the UK remains competitive and encouraging investment. This includes scrapping the carried interest loophole that provides a tax break for private equity bosses.

It also includes abolishing non-domiciled tax status and replacing it with a system for genuine temporary residents, as well as removing the tax loopholes enjoyed by private schools. In addition, it includes cracking down on tax evasion, tax avoidance and the use of offshore tax havens, ensuring that people and businesses are no longer able to avoid paying their fair share.

Returning to the specific issue of taxes on wealth, I can assure constituents that I will continue to monitor any developments on this matter in Parliament and will keep in mind the concerns you raise.
